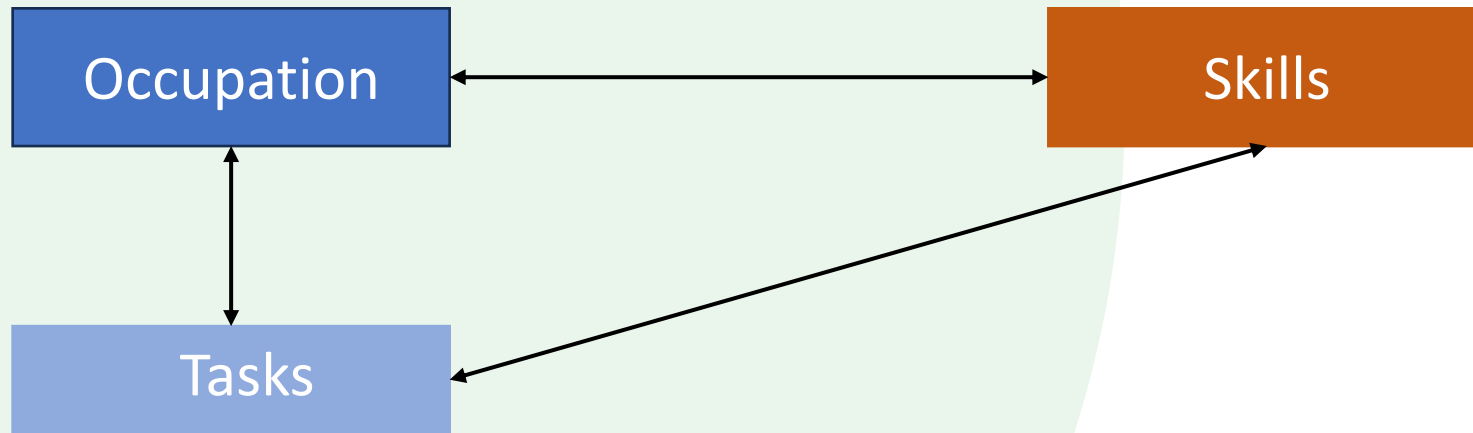

From Mis-communication to shared skill language |

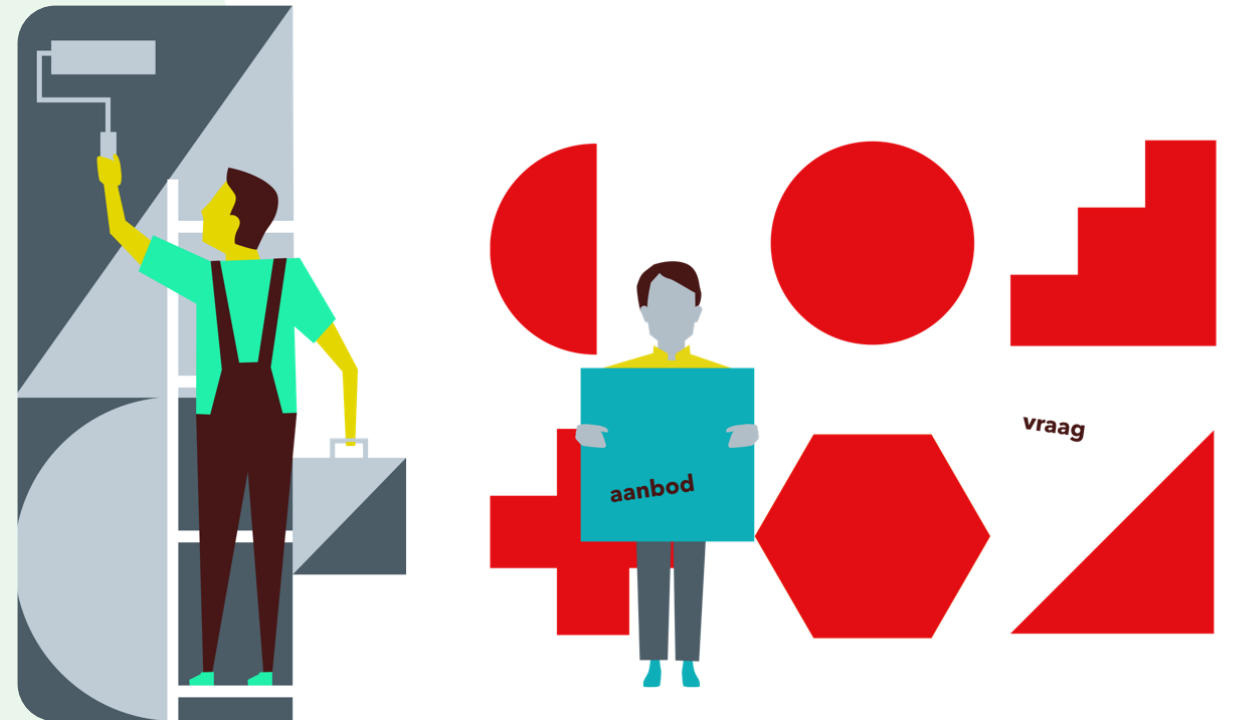
Helping talent and employer speak the same (skills) language using a standard taxonomy/ontology, e.g. ESCO, O*NET, CompetentNL

Talent profile does not match vacancy profile -> identifying learnable elements and providing additional training

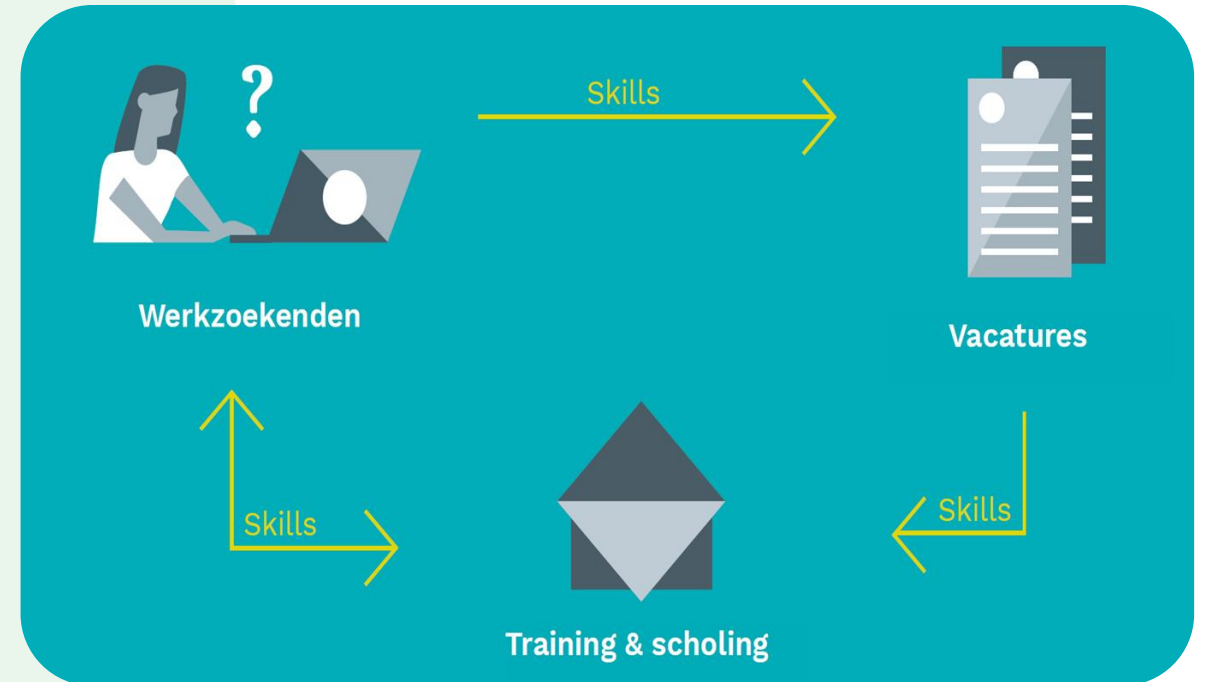
From Mis-encounter to a Transparent Education and Job Market |

- Educators



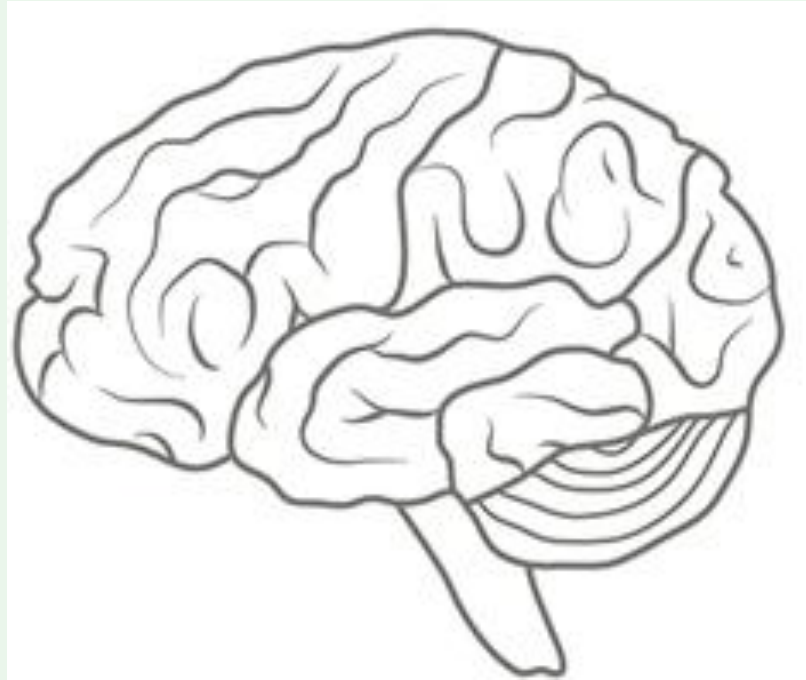

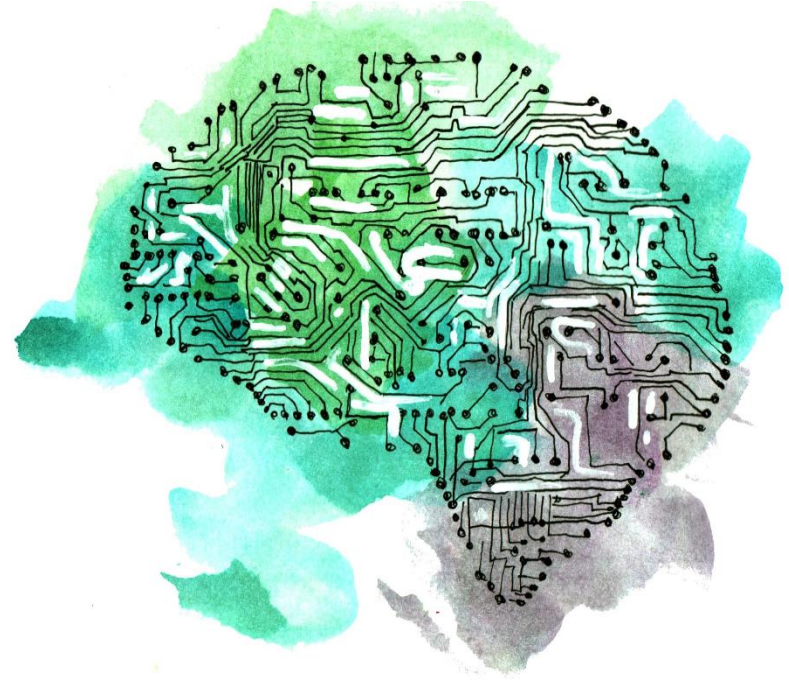
"Skills are the personal characteristics, conditions for competent performance of tasks in work settings, acquired through education, training and experience, that enable one to perform a work-related activity or task."

Types of Skillstaxonomy

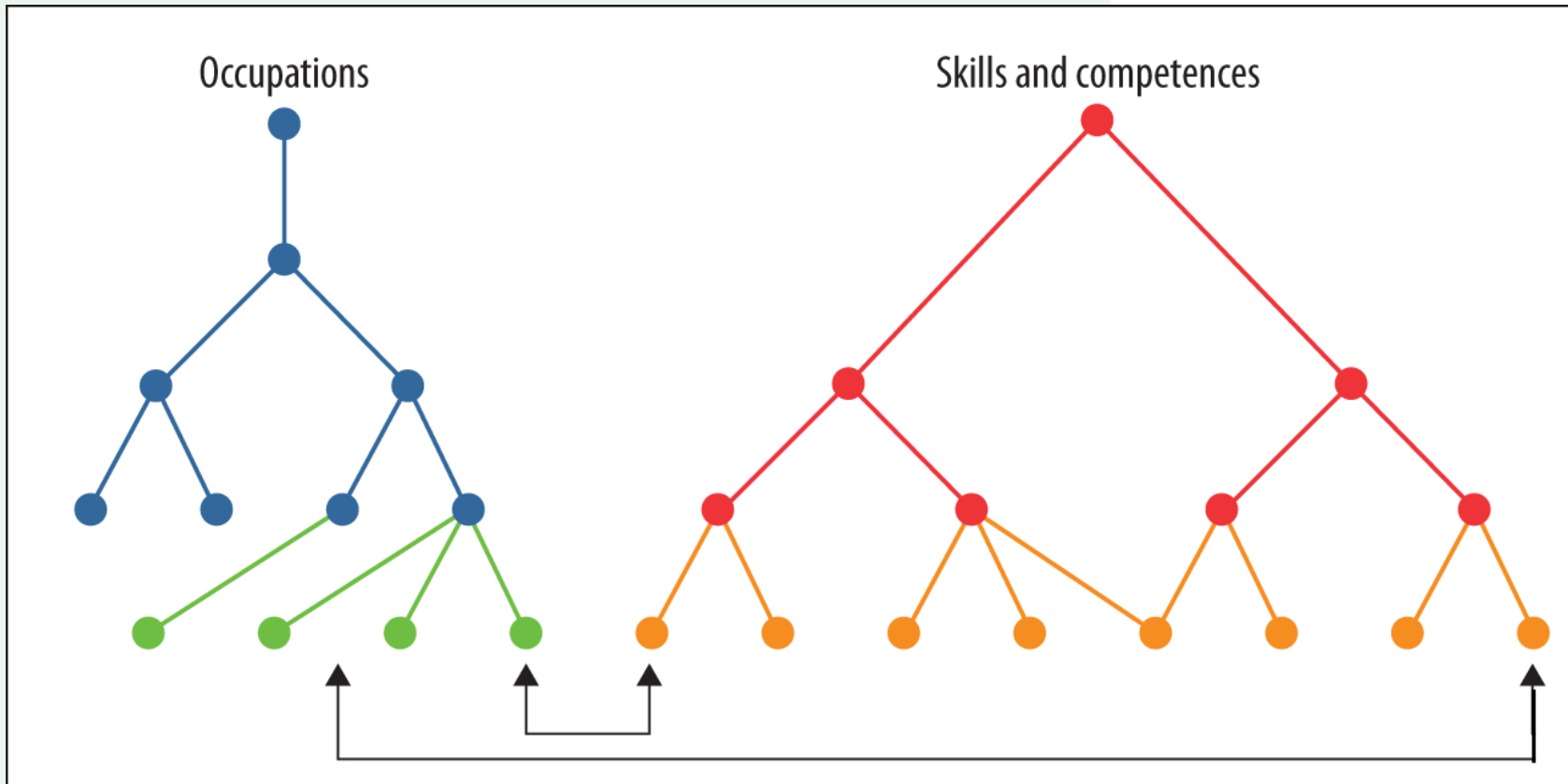
EXPERT-DEFINED TAXONOMY



DATA-DRIVEN TAXONOMY



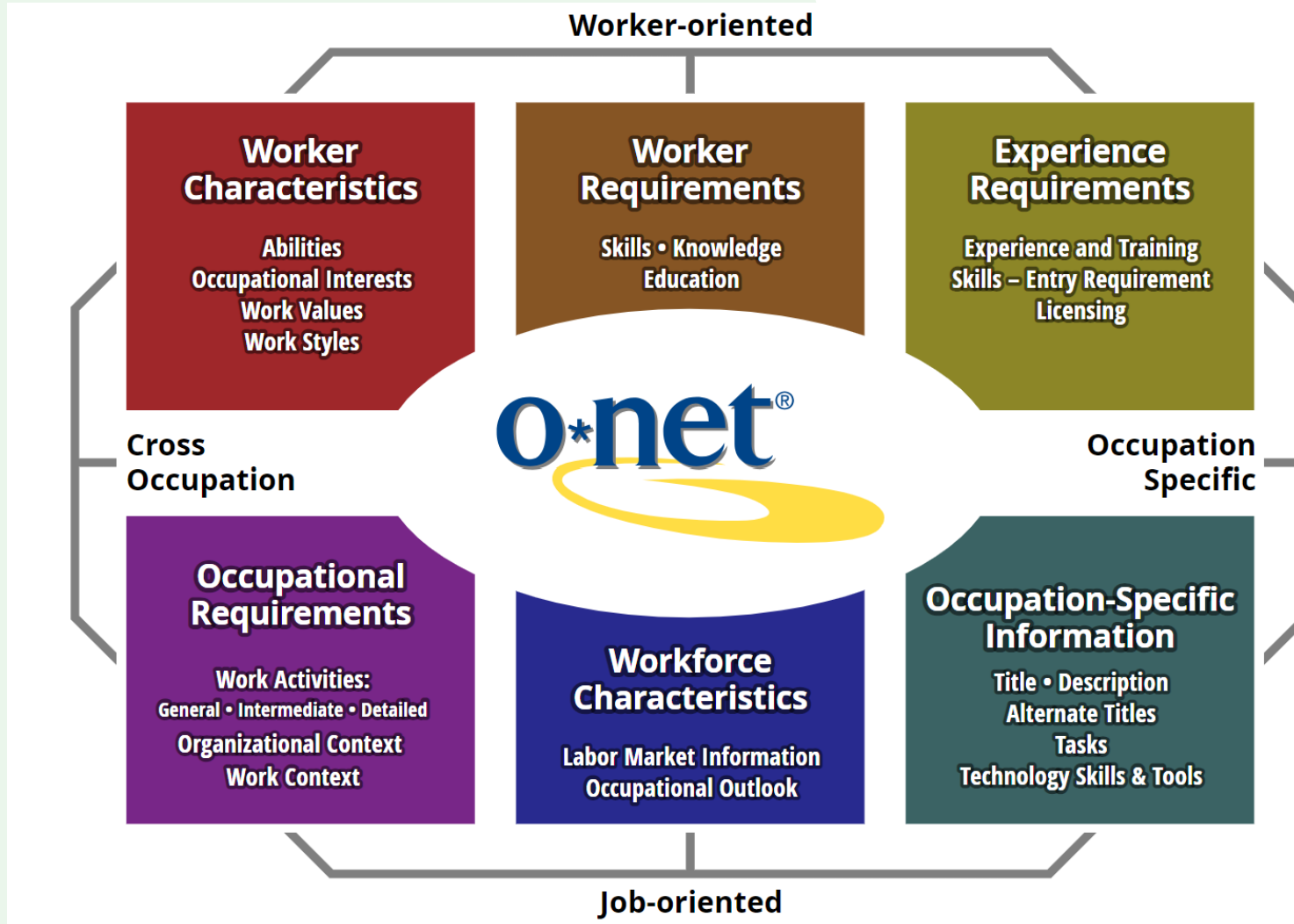

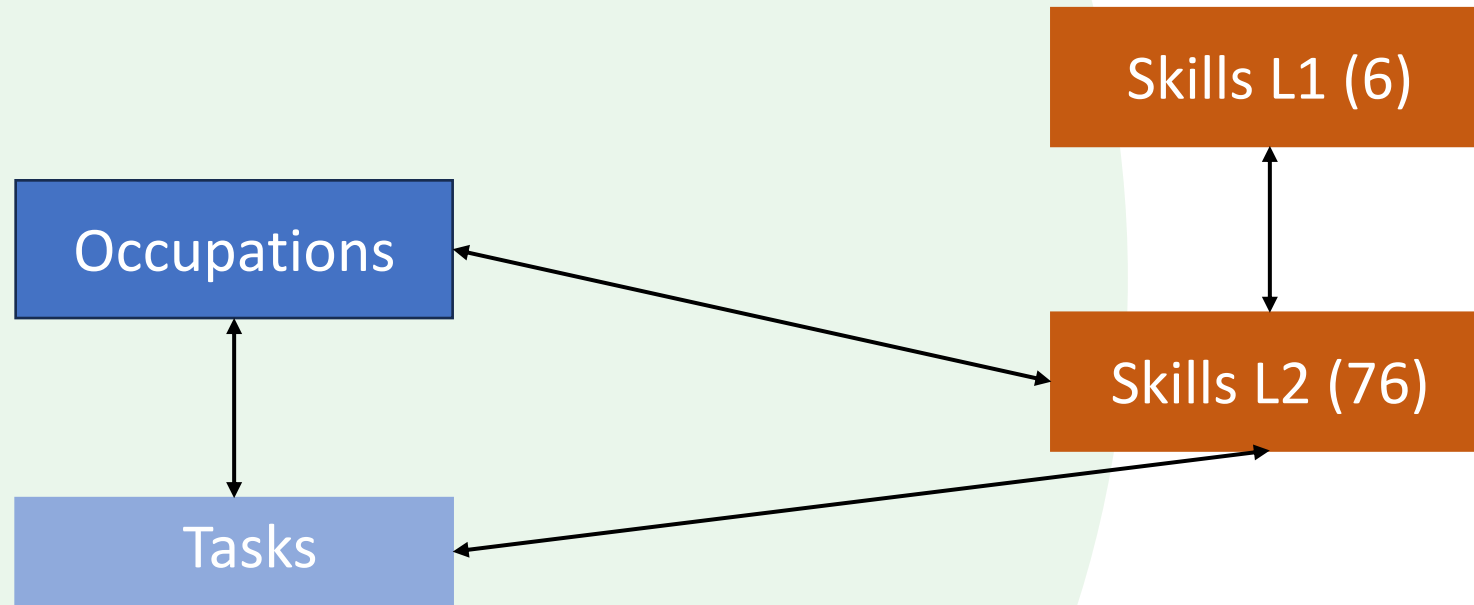
